## **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

When Transferring ownership after a sale, it is typically the SELLER'S responsibility to submit the transfer paperwork and pay the fee.

When you have bought a bred cow, the calf born (within the appropriate timeline) will be the BUYER'S responsibility to register the calf. You (the owner of the cow at date of birthing) will be considered the breeder, and thus the calf will be registered with your ranch name in the name of the calf.

# **Registration and Transfer papers** are available online at www.whitedexter.com.

- Forms are available for you to complete and submit electronically.
- Forms are also available to print out for completion to mail.
   (If you do not have access to a computer or printer, contact the registrar to have hard copies mailed to you.)

# Payment for registrations and transfers can be made several ways:

- PayPal there is a direct link on the website in the registration section to PayPal (Green "Pay Now" button). You do NOT need to have an account with PayPal, you can click "Pay with Debit or Credit Card" once you have clicked the green button.
- Credit card over the phone. You can call the registrar at 417-849-5830 to pay over the phone with your credit or debit card. This payment is made through Square and you can receive a receipt via email. An invoice can also be sent to you if you are unsure of the amount owed. Contact registrar with questions.
- Check you can mail a check to the registrar (with printed registration papers or for registrations submitted electronically).

## ANIMALS ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION

White animals are registerable in the White Dexter Cattle Registry (WDCR) if they meet the following criteria:

- Both parents are registered in WDCR. (have registration numbers)
- One parent is registered with WDCR and the other parent is registered in ONE of the following Dexter
  Associations: ADCA, PDCA, Legacy or CDCA Dexters. IMCBR papers are recognized only if the pedigrees are
  recorded through 4 generations showing nothing but White Dexter and/or approved Dexter pedigree
  information on both the sire and dam.

Black, red or dun HEIFERS born from the breeding of above-mentioned animals are registerable as White Dexter breeding stock (BS) and are used to further White Dexter breeding programs. An identifier will be placed at the end of the animal's name in the registry to easily show in the future the animal's features. BBSH= Black, breeding stock, horned. RBSP= Red, breeding stock, polled. This formula will also be used when registering Dexters from other registries. In the thirteen years of upgrading this breed we did not find the (BS) cows were any more likely to produce the white calves than any Dexter. However as with any breeding program if that heifer has bloodlines you want to keep, then by all means breed her with the appropriate White bull. Colored bulls born from breeding White Dexter to colored BS are not registered.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

The White Dexter Cattle Registry is a registry only. There are no memberships or membership dues. There are three people that are currently serving as advisors to assure the registry is maintained and kept accurate. Joanie Storck, Phillip Dill, and Dennis Salyers are considered the Founders and will be consulted on any questions that arise not covered in these guidelines.
